Saddam Shamshudin Shaikh Vs. State

(Phaltan City Police Station C. R. No.248/2026)

ORDER PASSED BELOW EXH.04.

(Dtd. 21.08.2026)

1] This is an ad interim anticipatory bail application under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023.

2] The applicant/accused **Saddam Shamshudin Shaikh** is apprehending his arrest in Crime No.248/2026 for the offences punishable under Sections 118(1), 119(1), 352, 351(2), 351(3), 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

3] The prosecution case is that :

The complainant Ilam Singh Kadar Singh Akhade lodged a complaint on 02/07/2026 at Phaltan City police station that he is permanent resident of Zapadipadla, post Dhanura, Tal. Sendhava, Dist. Badavani, Madhya Pradesh. He is temporarily residing at Zirapwadi, Tal. Phaltan, Dist. Satara. He used to do centring work along with his relatives. He use to work with one Rasul Bandenavaj Sayyed R/o. Gunwadi, Tal. Baramati, Dist. Pune. This Rasul Bandenavaj Sayyed had kidnapped his sister Limji and he had lodged complaint against him. This Rasul Sayyed had brought his sister on 17/06/2016 at Baramati city

police station and handed over her in his custody. He left his sister at his village and returned for his work at Zirapwadi. On 01/07/2026 he had come to Phaltan S.T. stand along with his relative Suresh More, Anil More, Ranjit More. He had gone with his relative Ranjit More to withdraw the money from ATM at Nana Patil Chowk Phaltan. He had withdrawn Rs. 3500/- from the ATM and he was standing in front of Morya Mobile shop. At that time, the accused Rasul Bandenavaj Sayyed, Munna Sayyed, Jishan Sayyed resident of Gunwadi, Tal. Baramati, District Pune, the accused Saddam Shaikh resident of Amarai, Tal. Baramati came near him and threatened him that he should send back his sister towards him and abused him. The accused Munna Sayyed, Jishan Sayyed, Saddam Shaikh assaulted him and his relative Ranjit more with fist and kick blows. The accused Rasul Sayyed picked up a iron rod and assaulted on his head on the back side and injured him. One of the accused robbed Rs. 50,000/- from his pant pockets and thereafter all of them went away. The complainant and his relative Ranjit More came to Phaltan police station to lodge a complaint against the accused. As there was bleeding injury on his head the police sent him for medical examination at government hospital Phaltan. The police registered the above offences against the accused and arrested Rasul Bandenavaj Sayyed.

4] The applicant accused states that he has not committed any offence, he is falsely implicated in this offence. He states that the police had arrested the main accused Rasul Bandenavaj Sayyed and he was sent to PCR. Thereafter the Ld. Judicial Magistrate First Class court has released him on regular bail. The other accused Munna Bandenawaj

Sayyad is released on anticipatory bail. He states that the police have recovered the iron rod used in this incident. He states that the allegations against him are that he has assaulted the complainant with fist blows. He states that there is nothing to be recovered from him. His custodial interrogation is not necessary. He is ready to co-operate the police in the investigation. He states that his custodial interrogation is not necessary. If he is arrested then he will suffer irreparable damage to his reputation. So he has prayed to release him on ad interim anticipatory bail.

5] Perused the papers filed along with the anticipatory bail application. The complainant has alleged that the accused Rasul Sayyad had assaulted him with iron rod. The present accused and the other accused had assaulted him with fist and kick blows. He has alleged that somebody had robbed Rs.50,000/- from his pocket. The police have already arrested the main accused Rasul Sayyad and recovered iron rod from him. There is nothing to be seized or recovered from the present accused. His custodial interrogation is not necessary. If the applicant/accused is directed to co-operate the investigation and to attend the police station as and when called by the Investigating Officer, it will serve the purpose of the prosecution. This is a fit case to release the applicant/accused on ad interim anticipatory bail till the say of the Addl. P.P. and police is called. So, I pass the following order :

ORDER

01. The ad interim anticipatory bail application of the applicant/accused **Saddam Shamshudin Shaikh** is hereby allowed.

02. The applicant/accused **Saddam Shamshudin Shaikh** be released

in Crime No.248/2026 registered under sections 118(1), 119(1), 352, 351(2), 351(3), 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 at Phaltan City Police Station, Phaltan, District- Satara if he is arrested, in this offence on his, executing P. R. bond of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount till the say of Addl. P P and police is filed.

03. The applicant/accused should not tamper the prosecution evidence and he should not abscond.

04. The applicant/accused should co-operate the investigating officer and attend the police station as and when called by the Investigating Officer.
