At this stage O.P has appeared and he has also filed an application to set aside the order dt.10.09.24 whereby the case was fixed for ex parte and permit him to contest the present case.

He has also submitted his written objection after supplying copy to the petitioner.

Heard Ld. Advocate for the petitioner and the Ld. Advocate for the O.P.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioner raises strong objection against such prayer of the respondent and has submitted that there is no such explanation in his application about his conduct as well as it does not carry any such statement to accept the W.S.

Ld. Advocate for the respondent submits that there was no such in-ordinate delay and the respondent wants to contest the present case which is his right. The same should not be curtailed at the cost of mere submission of the petitioner.

Heard and considered the same.

It is a fact that this is a dispute between husband and wife over their right and presence of respondent to decide the dispute is required for a just decision.

Considering the nature of the suit the prayer of the respondent is hereby allowed subject to cost of Rs.3000/- to be paid by the respondent to the petitioner.

On payment of the cost amount W/S be accepted.
