

State of Haryana VS Lucky & anr**:19:**

Present: Sh. Ravinder Singh, Ld. APP for the State.
Accused Lucky and Ram Kumar on bail with Sh. Mohit Jindal, Advocate.

Today, the case was fixed for defence evidence. Defence evidence closed by accused by making a separate statement.

Arguments heard. Judgment pronounced. Vide separate judgment of even date, accused namely **Lucky and Ram Kumar** present in court are hereby **acquitted** of the charge levelled against them.

Since, accused has been **acquitted** of the charges levelled against him, as per the provision of Section 437-A of Cr.P.C/section 481 of BNSS, 2023, accused are directed to furnish fresh **personal bonds** in the sum of ₹25,000/-, which would remain in force for six months to secure his presence before the Ld. Appellate Court, if need be, if any appeal against this judgment is preferred by the prosecution/complainant. Requisite bonds furnished, accepted and attested. Original relevant documents, if any on record belonging to any party be returned after the expiry of period of appeal/revision. Concerned Revenue Authority is directed to delete the name of surety in the revenue record as per law. Superdignama, if any, is also discharged. Case property, if any, be disposed of, as per the rules, after expiry of period of appeal/revision, if any. File be consigned to records, after due compliance.
