Today, the case was fixed as last opportunity for concluding the prosecution evidence. Learned APP has given a statement that as the complainant has turned hostile, and there are no chance of improvement of prosecution case, and so he closed prosecution evidence. The statement is separately recorded and placed on file.

Statements of accused person under Section 313 Cr.P.C recorded and accused opted not to lead any evidence in defence.

Arguments heard. Vide my separate judgment of even date, **accused Nama Ram is acquitted** of the charges framed against him. His bail bonds and surety bonds stands discharged. Case property if any, be dealt with as per rules after the expiry of period of appeal or revision.

Since, accused has been **acquitted** of the charges levelled against him, as per the amended provision of Section section 481 of BNSS, 2023, accused is directed to furnish fresh **personal** bonds in the sum of Rs.25,000/-, which would remain in force for six months to secure their presence before the Ld. Appellate Court, if need be, if any appeal against this judgment is preferred by the prosecution/complainant. Requisite bonds furnished, accepted and attested. Papers be attached with the main file. File be consigned to the record room, after due compliance.
