NDPS Case No. 32 of 2023

Order No. 12 Dated: 18.09.2024

Today the investigating officer moves one written prayer through the Ld. P.P. praying for allowing him to interrogate two accused persons namely Surabali Sk and Ejajul Sk who are presently said to have been detained in the Midnapore Central Correctional Home in connection with NDPS Case no. 17 of 2024 arising out of Kharagpur GRPS case no. 99/2024 dated 19.06.2024 u/s. 20(b)(ii)(C)/29 of NDPS Act.

While forwarding the above prayer, the Ld. Public Prosecutor submitted that when the contraband was seized from Shalimar Railway Station which was kept in a trolley bag, one railway ticket and Aadhar Card were also seized and subsequently from the seized railway ticket as verified from the railway authority, the names of the above two accused persons got disclosed who are sought to be interrogated in the Midnapore Central Correctional Home for the purpose of investigation of this case.

While considering the above prayer I have carefully perused the CD of the case particularly the seizure list wherefrom it is shown that the above railway ticket and Aadhar Card were allegedly recovered and seized from the trolley bag in which the contrabands (narcotic substance) was allegedly available.

Keeping in view of the above prima facie evidence, the prayer of the investigating officer allowing him to do necessary jail interrogation of the two accused persons namely Surabali Sk and Ejajul Sk who are detained in Midnapore Central Correctional Home in connection with NDPS Case no. 17 of 2024 arising out of Kharagpur GRPS case no. 99/2024 dated 19.06.2024 u/s. 20(b)(ii)(C)/29 of NDPS Act is considered and allow for the sake of investigation of this case.

As a result, the Superintendent, Midnapore Central Correctional Home is directed to allow the investigating officer of this case to interrogate the above named two accused persons namely Surabali Sk and Ejajul Sk for the sake of investigation of this case.

Thus, let a copy of this order be given to the investigating officer of this case for his information and necessary action, who is specifically directed to communicate this order well in advance to the Superintendent of Midnapore Correctional Home through E-mail before the officer proceeds for such jail interrogation.
