

**J.O. Code WB00885**  
**T. R. Case No. 32 of 2023**

**Order No. 05 dated 20-12-2023.**

The record is put up by petition filed on behalf of prosecution, who forwards an application praying for issuance of DO letter in favour of the Director-cum-Senior Chemical Examiner, F.S.L, 37/1/2, Belgachia Road, Kol-37 for supplying the chemical examination report to the I/O of his authorized representative.

Perused the application as well as other materials on record.

Heard the Ld. Counsel as well as I/O in person, who alleges that while he has been told that the chemical examination report is otherwise ready, the same was not handed over to his authorised representative, for reasons best known to the F.S.L authorities. This is a case U/s 20(b)(ii)(C) of the N.D.P.S Act, where commercial quantity of contraband is alleged to have been seized from the possession of the accused person. There is no reason to the F.S.L authorities, not to hand over the F.S.L report, if the same has already been prepared, to hand over the same to the I/O or his authorised representative.

Be that as it may, the Director-cum-Senior Chemical Examiner, Forensic Science Laboratory, 37/1/2, Belgachia Road, Kol-37 is requested to complete the work of chemical examination of the sample of purported contraband and to hand over the same to the I/O or his authorised representative, without any further delay. The application filed by the I/O is accordingly disposed off.
