Today is fixed for hearing of bail petition filed on behalf of all four accused persons, in J/C, on 01-06-2026.

Ld. P.P-in-charge representing the State and Ld. Advocates of the accused persons are present.

The CD is produced.

Now, the bail petition filed on behalf of four accused persons is taken up for hearing.

Heard the Ld. Defence Counsel, who has submitted that the accused persons have been detained in custody for a substantial period of time and chargesheet has already been submitted and that the accused persons are local people and having no chance of absconding and accordingly, they may be enlarged on bail.

Ld. P.P-in-charge raises vehement objection against the bail petition filed on behalf of the accused persons.

Perused materials on record, and the CD.

The present case has been initiated against the accused persons alleging the brutal death of the victim following assault by the accused, who are two brothers and parents of the victim.

The materials on records and CD including postmortem report, reveals that there were 21 stitches over the head of the victim and offending weapon has been seized by the investigating authority.

Considering the nature and gravity of the offence, taking note of the fact that if the accused persons have been enlarged on bail the chance of their absconding cannot be ruled out, bail prayer is considered and rejected.
