

**In the Court of the ADJ/Judge, Spl Court (Elec. Act),
4th Court, Howrah.
Electricity Case no. 211 of 2006.**

Order No. 32 dated 30.06.16.

Record is put up today on the prayer of accused person viz Provash Dey who is present before this court with his Ld. Advocate.

One application pleading guilty has been filed by the said accused. Ld. Advocate on behalf of the accused person and Ld. PP in charge are present. The application for pleading guilty is taken up for hearing and order.

Copy served. No objection is raised.

Hd. both sides. Perused the prayer of the accused person. Considered.

The accused person may plead guilty at any stage of the proceeding of pending trial. So, I am inclined to allow his prayer.

At the outset, the accusation is stated to the accused person to which he pleaded guilty submitting his guilt of the offence. Pleading guilty is voluntary.

Accordingly, the plea of guilt made by the accused person is accepted and he is convicted for the offence punishable U/S 135 of The Electricity Act.

At the outset of consideration on the point of sentence, I find that the accused person voluntarily pleading guilty. Considering above, I am inclined to sentence the accused person/petitioner to pay a fine of Rs 1,000/- only id to suffer S.I. for 15 days.

Recall W.A. at once.

The instant case is hereby disposed of.

The accused person be set at liberty at once subject to payment of fine amount.
