ORDER:

1. The present bail application put up before me being Duty Officer during summer vacation.
2. Present application has been filed on behalf of applicant/accused **Arjan Singh** seeking anticipatory bail in the above noted matter.
3. The facts of the present case are that are that on 08.06.2026 ASI Beant Singh alongwith police party were on patrolling duty in the area of Mohkam Aryan on private vehicle where informer informed that Arjan Singh son of Jeet Singh son of Sher Singh r/o Dhani Natha Singh is habitual

of selling illicit liquor. If raid be conducted he can apprehended with heavy quantity of liquor on his motor-cycle. Since the information being credible, ruqa was sent to the police station for registration of FIR. Thereafter, accused was apprehended along with 10 bottles and 180Mls illicit liquor.

4. It is because of the above said FIR that applicant/accused is apprehending his arrest in the present case.

5. Upon notice, Sh. Amandeep Sharma, learned Additional PP for the State appeared, but he has not filed the reply to the present application and he has orally opposed the present bail application.

6 SI Ranjeet Singh No. 873/PAP of PS Sadar Jalalabad appeared and suffered statement that 16 bottles and 180mls illicit liquor have been recovered from accused/applicant and notice under section 35(4) of BNSS has already been given to him. His custodial interrogation is not required and he may kindly be directed to join investigation.

7. Police record has been produced and perused.

8. I have heard learned counsel for the applicant/accused, learned Additional PP for the State and have gone through the file carefully with their able assistance.

9. Contention of Sh. Manga Singh Kachura, Advocate, learned arguing counsel for applicant/accused is that accused has been falsely implicated in the present. Argument is that recovery has already been effected was effected and nothing remained to be recovered from the applicant. The applicant is ready to furnish the bail bonds. The custodial interrogation of accused is not required in any manner and thus prayed that the application for anticipatory bail may be allowed.

10. After going through the facts and circumstances and allegations involved in the case are matter of proof and in view of the above said statement of SI Ranjeet Singh, this court can consider that it is a fit cas where the concession of anticipatory bail can be granted.

11. Adjourned to 08.07.2026 for report.

12. In the meantime, applicant/accused **Arjun Singh** is directed to join the investigation and fully co-operative with the investigating agency. On his doing so, he will be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the investigating officer/SHO/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions as mentioned in Section 482 (2) of BNSS. In case, accused/applicant failed to join the investigation within the stipulated period, then application for anticipatory bail will to be deemed to be dismissed.
