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ORDER

This order will dispose of bail application filed by applicants/accused Vicky Singh, Lovepreet Singh alias Lovi, Gurpreet Singh and Jashandeep Singh alias Deepu under Section 483 BNSS for releasing them on bail in case bearing FIR No.119 dated 05.07.2025, under Sections 331(4), 305 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS) 2023, Police Station, Sardulgarh, District Mansa.

2. Upon notice, this application was contested by learned Public Prosecutor for the State.

3. I have heard learned counsel for the applicants and learned Public Prosecutor for the State and have gone through the file very carefully with their able assistance.

4. Learned counsel for the applicants/accused has argued that applicants/accused are innocent and have been falsely implicated in this case. They have not committed any offence. Nothing was recovered from possession of the accused/applicants. They have no concern with the alleged recovery. Nothing is to be recovered from the applicants. Accused/applicants are in judicial custody since 22.08.2025 and as such, they are no more required by the police for the purpose of investigation. Challan has already been presented in the Court of learned SDJM, Sardulgarh and it will take sufficient time for completion of trial. No useful purpose will be served by detaining the accused indefinitely in the judicial custody except burden on the State Exchequer. Even the

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accused are not in a position to tamper with the prosecution evidence or to abscond from the Court proceedings. Hence, it is prayed that bail application may kindly be allowed.

5. On the other hand, learned Public Prosecutor for the State contended that offence attributed to accused/applicants is very serious in nature and no leniency is required in such like matters. Hence, prayed for dismissal of the bail application.

6. From perusal of the police file, this Court finds that this case was registered on the statement of Rajesh Kumar son of Radhy Shyam. In his statement, he has stated that he is working as a technician in Elevar (ATC) Mobile Tower Company and one of their tower is installed at village Bhagwanpur Hingna. On 21.06.2025, at about 2:34 a.m. he received a call regarding closing of the tower and when he went to the spot, he found that some persons had committed theft from the tower, articles of Airtel company i.e. power cable 200 meters, RRU-4, jumper-16, Cipri-4, SFT-4 and articles of RJIO Company i.e. RRU-8, Cipri-8, jumper-32, power cable 200 meters and value of these articles was around Rs.60,000/-. Till date he was looking after the persons who had committed theft and now he has come to know that theft from the said tower was committed by Lovepreet Singh alias Lovi, son of Kewal Singh, Vicky Singh son of Jagdev Singh, Gurpreet Singh son of Ajaib Singh, Jashandeep Singh alias Deepu son of Satgur Singh, Gurpiar Singh alias Guri son of Nirbhai Singh, residents of Sheron, Police Station, Cheema,

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District Sangrur. On the basis of this statement, the present case was registered against the accused/applicants and others under Sections 331(4) and 305 of BNS. Applicants/accused were arrested in this case on 22.08.2025. The criminal liability of the accused under Sections 331(4), 305 of BNS cannot be ascertained at this state. Investigation is complete and challan has already been submitted against the accused in the Court of SDJM, Sardulgarh. All the offences attributed to accused/applicants are triable by the Court of Magistrate. It will take sufficient time for completion of trial. No useful purpose will be served by detaining the accused indefinitely in judicial custody, except burden on the State Exchequer. Even there is no apprehension that accused are in a position to tamper with the prosecution evidence or to abscond from the court proceedings. As such, keeping in view the totality of the circumstances and without expressing anything on merits of the present case, the bail application is hereby allowed and the applicants/accused are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds to the tune of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Illaqa/Duty Magistrate, Police Station, Sardulgarh with the condition that applicants/accused shall neither leave the country without prior permission of the Court nor they shall tamper with the witnesses of the prosecution; they shall appear before the learned trial Court on each and every date of hearing; and they shall not commit an offence similar to the offence of which they are accused, or suspected, of the commission of

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which they are suspected (as provided under Section 480(3) of BNSS).
Police record be returned immediately and copy of this order be sent to
the concerned learned Illaqa/Duty Magistrate. File of bail application be
consigned to record room.
