Virtual court room set up through Video App. Learned Addl.PP for State is online from her office.

Report from P.S. Baghapurana received to the effect that neither any case found to be registered against the applicants-petitioner nor any application is pending for inquiry from last six months. However, a report has been received from the DSP Baghapurana to the effect that an application bearing No. 968-C.P/20 dated 25.07.2020 moved by one Balwant Singh for not returning of Rs. 27,00,000/- in regard to settlement of account to him by the applicants-petitioners which is pending for inquiry.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for applicants submitted that since police is calling the applicant time and again and harassing them so present bail application be allowed and police be directed to issue prior notice to applicants before arresting them in case the police intends to arrest the applicants. On the other hand, learned Addl. P.P. for the State opposed all the contentions raised by learned counsel for applicants and submitted that no anticipatory bail can be granted to applicants as there is no such apprehension of their arrest in view of abovesaid report.

After hearing the respective contentions raised by both the sides and in view of the report received today in the court, present bail application is rendered infructuous and the same is dismissed as infructuous. However, if at any stage investigating agency wants to arrest the applicants-petitioners concerning the allegations mentioned in the blanket bail application, they would serve three days notice upon the applicants/petitioners, before effecting their arrest. This order shall remain in force for four

months from today. Bail application stands disposed of accordingly.
