ORDER:

1. Present application filed on behalf of applicant/accused

Karan Singh @ Jaskaran Singh seeking pre arrest bail in the matter,

details of which have been referred above, shall be disposed off through

this order.
2. The FIR in this case has been registered against 13 persons

by name and 4/5 unknown persons on the basis of information having

been received by ASI Mahinder Singh on 18.06.2024 that on said day at

about 12:30 PM Sunny Rattanpuria armed with revolver, Pritpal @ Preeta armed with pistol, Sukhpal Singh @ Palu armed with kapa, Baljit Singh @ Babbu Soi armed with pistol, Happy Singh armed with pistol, Parkash Singh armed with kirpan, Karan Singh @ Pundi armed with kapa, Angrej Singh @ Geji armed with kirpan, Karan Sagar armed with kapa, Sajan armed with kirpan, Karan (*applicant*) armed with kapa, Sonu Singh armed with kapa, Sajanpreet Singh armed with pistol alongwith 4/5 unidentified persons earlier made nuisance at Mandi Arniwala and on that day they while riding on their respective motorcycles armed with weapons are chasing Gurpreet Singh son of Gurmeet Singh and Gurpreet Singh son of Joginder Singh and with intention to kill them, are making direct fire in the air which may hit any passerby and they also caused injuries with kapa/kirpan. On the basis of this information, the present FIR was registered.

3. Notice of the bail application was served upon the State through learned Additional PP alongwith copy of bail application, who received the same, appeared and contested the bail application on merits. Police record was requisitioned which has been received and perused.

4. I have heard the respective contentions of both the learned Advocates and have perused the record with their able assistance.

5. As per record, the accused is stated to be armed with kapa at the time of occurrence however, no injury has been attributed to him. The accused-applicant is ready to join investigation and to cooperate with the investigating agency. Since there is no overt injury attributed to the

accused-applicant as such, the custodial interrogation of the applicant-accused does not seem necessary. Hence, the bail application of accused stands allowed. The applicant is directed to join investigation accordingly and in the event of his arrest, the arresting officer of concerned Police Station is directed to release the applicant on bail on his furnishing bail bonds to his/her satisfaction and subject to the conditions under Section 438 (2) Cr.PC. File be consigned to the record room.
