ORDER

This order of mine shall dispose of the application for regular bail in the aforementioned First Information Report filed by the petitioner-accused under Section 483 of BNSS.

2. An affidavit was attached along-with the bail application on behalf of the petitioner-accused that no such other bail application is pending in any Court of law except present one.

3. Reply to the bail application was filed by the Investigating Officer, also forwarded by the Ld. Public Prosecutor appearing for the State.

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4. Briefly stated, as per the case made by the investigating agency, on 10.06.2026, ASI Surender Singh along-with other police officials was present on patrolling and intelligence duty at Pehowa Chowk, Pehowa, when he received a secret information that the present petitioner was engaged in selling Opium and he would go to Pehowa from Assandh via National Highway No.152D in his car bearing registration No.HR41M-2750, having the possession of the said contraband. Upon receiving this information, ASI Surender Singh prepared the raiding party and started checking on Pehowa-Kurukshetra road. In the meantime, ASI Ram Kumar, second Investigating Officer, reached at the spot and took over the investigation. Thereupon, the petitioner was apprehended along-with his car, having the possession of 1 kg 7 gm Opium.

5. Accordingly, a tehrir was written and sent to the police station, basis on which, the instant criminal case was registered. The petitioner was arrested and he was lying in judicial custody since 10.06.2026. Therefore, he moved this application for regular bail.

6. I have heard the arguments advanced by learned counsel for the accused-petitioner and the learned Public Prosecutor for the State.

7. As per the allegations, the petitioner was found having the possession of 1 kg 7 gm Opium in his car bearing registration No.HR41M-2750 on 10.06.2026 by the police team headed by ASI Ram Kumar on the basis of secret information. The quantity of the contraband, allegedly

recovered from the petitioner, was intermediate i.e. more than the small quantity, but lesser than the commercial quantity. The investigation as well as subsequent trial are likely to take a considerable time and the petitioner, who is already lying in custody since 10.06.2026, may not be kept behind bars for an indefinite period. Therefore, the bail application of the petitioner is hereby **allowed**, subject to his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of learned Illaqa/Duty Magistrate. A copy of this order be sent to the Court of learned Illaqa Magistrate for information and necessary compliance and with the direction to forward the requisite bail bonds to this Court.

8. None of the opinion recorded above by this Court in the instant order would affect the merits of the case in any manner in future and the same are recorded only for the purpose of determination of application for bail. File be consigned to the record room after due compliance.
