Order No.03 dated 13.03.2026.

The instant Criminal Misc. Case arising out of an application seeking permission to go out of India, in connection with Amta P.S Case No. 256 of 2025 dated 27.10.2025 u/Ss.318(4)/316(2)/351(2)/3(5) of BNS, filed by the accused/petitioner namely, Payel Jana, is taken up for hearing.

Perused the petition.

Heard Ld. Advocate on behalf of the petitioner.

Ld. Public Prosecutor does not raise any objection.

Seen the order granting anticipatory bail.

It appears that at the time of granting anticipatory bail to the petitioner the condition for compliance of section 482(2) BNSS was imposed. In view of the condition stated in the above provision, the petitioner was directed not to leave India without prior permission of the Court. Now, it is submitted before this Court that the petitioner being Cabin Crew of Etihad Airways by profession need to travel out of India as part of her duty. Accordingly, the prayer for permission to travel out of India is made.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioner submitted that similar relief was granted by this Court vide order dated 10.12.2025.

Ld.P.P has also fairly submitted that such an opportunity may be given.

Having considered the profession of the petitioner and the nature of the case, this Court finds it proper to allow the petitioner to travel out of India in order to continue in her service in Etihad Airways as Cabin Crew as refusing such relief might put her employment in jeopardy and hinder her right to livelihood.

The permission is given to travel out of India for a period of three months or till furnishing of the report in final form, whichever is earlier. The period of three months shall commence from the date of the instant order.

C.D and L.C.R. be returned, if any.

The Cr. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.

Let a copy of the order be sent to the Ld. Jurisdictional Court for information and taking necessary action.
