The application u/S.483 BNSS arising out of Shibpur P.S. Case No. 188 of 2026 dated 07.05.2026 u/Ss. 191(2)/191(3)/190/118(2)/109/324(4)/ 351(1) of BNS and 25/27 Arms Act & 3/ 4 E.S Act filed by the accused/petitioner namely, Nizamuddin @ Kalim, is taken up for hearing.

The accused/petitioner has stated on affidavit that no application has been pending or rejected before or by the Hon'ble High Court till date.

Perused the petition and the C.D. Heard both sides.

Ld. Advocate appearing for the petitioner submitted that the accused/petitioner is in custody from 08.05.2026 and the allegations made therein are false and fabricated and the FIR has been lodged due to political rivalry and it is prayed to enlarge him on bail on any condition as this Court may deem fit and proper.

Ld. P.P appearing for the State referred the relevant portion of the C.D and submitted to reject the prayer for bail and it is further submitted that the present petitioner has past antecedents of committing similar and other grave offences.

On perusal of the record it appears that this case relates to the alleged offence punishable u/Ss. 191(2)/191(3)/190/118(2)/109/ 324(4)/ 351(1) of BNS and 25/27 Arms Act & 3/ 4 E.S Act, and it is alleged in the FIR that on 07.05.2026 in between 2.30 PM to 3 PM, the FIR named accused persons including the present petitioner along with about 100 unknown persons attacked the locality of the de facto complainant and created terror amongst the residents by hurling bombs and firing indiscriminately and as a result, the de facto complainant and others sustained injuries.

On perusal of the materials lying in the C.D., it appears to me that the investigation is in progress and sufficient incriminating materials are accumulated against the present petitioner.

However, considering the period of detention of the present petitioner, I am inclined to enlarge him on bail.

Hence, it is

Ordered -

that the application under section 483 of BNSS filed by the accused/petitioner is considered and allowed.

The accused/petitioner namely, Nizamuddin @ Kalim, may find bail on furnishing bond of Rs.3,000/- with two regd. sureties of Rs.1,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of Ld. C.J.M, Howrah with condition to meet the I.O once in a week till submission of the charge sheet and with further condition not to enter into the jurisdiction of Shibpur PS except for the purpose of meeting I.O.

C.D and T.C.R be returned, if any.

The Cr. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.

Let a copy of the order be sent to the Ld. C.J.M, Howrah for information and taking necessary action.
