First Bail Application under Section 483 of B.N.S.S.

Present: Ms. Anandita Sharma, Advocate for applicant-accused.

O R D E R:

1. Applicant-accused, vide this application under Section 483 of B.N.S.S., has sought regular bail in FIR No.194 dated 03.09.2025, under Section 21 of N.D.P.S. Act, Police Station City, Nawanshahr, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar.
2. Notice of the application was given to the State, pursuant to which learned Addl. Public Prosecutor, has put in appearance and filed

reply. As reported by the learned Addl. Public Prosecutor for the State, no other bail application of applicant-accused, is pending in any other court of law, including Hon'ble High Court.

3. Heard.

4. Brief facts, relevant for disposal of present bail application, are that applicant-accused, was intercepted by police on 03.09.2025, at about 07:00 p.m., when applicant-accused, who was seen coming on foot, threw one polythene pouch on the side of the road, and tried to flee from the spot and was apprehended on the basis of suspicion. From the envelope, thrown by applicant-accused on the ground, 06 grams Heroin was recovered.

5. The alleged recovery from applicant-accused is non-commercial. Applicant-accused is in custody since 03.09.2025. As per reply submitted by the prosecution, no other FIR under NDPS Act has been registered against applicant-accused. The presentation of challan and the conclusion of trial shall take time. The bail application is, thus, allowed and applicant-accused is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond in the sum of ₹30,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of learned Area/Duty Magistrate, subject to the following conditions : –

- i) that applicant-accused will appear in the court on each and every date of hearing;
- ii) that applicant-accused will not tamper with the prosecution evidence;
- iii) that applicant-accused will not leave India without prior permission of the court.

6. Ahlmad is directed to send the copy of this order, through Email, to Superintendent of concerned jail, as well as, to Secretary,

D.L.S.A., Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar. Police record be returned forthwith. File of bail application be consigned to the record room.
