Name-**Smt. Papiya Ghosh**, W/o Sri. Uttam Sarkar, age-30 years, Residence- Pitra, Udaipur, District- Gomati Tripura, Occupation-Home Maker.

Examination-In-Chief

1. I am the complainant of this case. About 10 years back my marriage was solemnized with Sri. Uttam Sarkar of Ghosh Khamar as per social rights and ceremonies. After marriage I started living at my matrimonial home. For six months I led a happy married life. Soon thereafter my husband would often assault me. He even started not looking after our livelihood. He frequently would not come home at night and stay his different friend's houses. My husband was then deep into taking drugs. When I got conceived and was into four months of my pregnancy, my husband left me for Chennai. During the periods my father used to take care of me and in the process he spend huge amount of money. Subsequently my husband returned home from Chennai only to leave me again for Chennai. Despite my objections, my husband did not consuming drugs. He would often beat me up demanding money so as to consume drugs. Subsequently, one day my husband including my in laws assaulted me mercilessly. My husband tried to kill me by tying gamcha around my neck. Some how I managed to get of their hands and called police personnel who then came to the spot and save me. Subsequently, I filed this case against my husband and in laws. The ejahar petition was scribed by a person nearby P.R. Bari PS. This is my signature on the said ejahar petition[Ext. P1/PW1]

Cross-Examination

1. At present I do not recall the dates when my husband and in laws assaulted me.
2. The last incident of assaults was at night and as such nearby residents could not have had an opportunity to witness the same.
3. It is not a fact that my statement that " For six months I led a happy married life. Soon thereafter my husband would often assault me. He even started not looking after our livelihood. He frequently would not come home at night and stay his different friend's

houses. My husband was then deep into taking drugs. When I got conceived and was into four months of my pregnancy, my husband left me for Chennai. During the periods my father used to take care of me and in the process he spend huge amount of money. Subsequently my husband returned home from Chennai only to leave me again for Chennai. Despite my objections, my husband did not consuming drugs. He would often beat me up demanding money so as to consume drugs. Subsequently, one day my husband including my in laws assaulted me mercilessly. My husband tried to kill me by tieing gamcha around my neck. Some how I managed to get of their hands and called police personnel who then came to the spot and save me,” are not true.

5. It is not a fact that today I am deposing falsely.

Examination-In-Chief

1. Complainant Papiya Ghosh is my daughter. About 10 years back her marriage was solemnized with Sri. Uttam Sarkar of Ghosh Khamar as per social rights and ceremonies. After marriage she started living at her matrimonial home. For one year she led a happy married life. Soon thereafter her husband with her in laws would often assault her. Several panchayat meetings were also held to bring an end to the problem, however, the same yield no results. When my daughter was into four months of her pregnancy, her husband left her for Chennai. During the periods I used to take care of my daughter after I have taken her to my home. Subsequently her husband returned home from Chennai only to leave me again for Chennai. Her husband was deep in to consuming drugs. Finding no solution to the problem, finally I brought my daughter to my home.

Cross-Examination

1. At present I do not recall the dates when her husband and in laws assaulted my daughter.

2. It is not a fact that my statement that “ For one year she led a happy married life. Soon thereafter her husband with her in laws would often assault her. Several panchayat meetings were also held to bring an end to the problem, however, the same yield no results. When my daughter was into four months of her pregnancy, her husband left her for Chennai. During the periods I used to take care of my daughter after I have taken her to my home. Subsequently her husband returned home from Chennai only to leave me again for Chennai. Her husband was deep in to consuming drugs” are not true.

4. No documents were submitted by my daughter to show that panchayat meetings were held.

5. It is not a fact that today I am deposing falsely at the behaved of my daughter
