Sh. Umesh Joshi, Ld. Counsel for the plaintiff, who has appeared through VC has submitted that the plaintiff bank was having only one address of the defendant, which is mentioned in the memo of the parties and submitted that defendant could not be served on the said address and submitted that since the plaintiff does not have any other address of the defendant, so, the defendant may ordered to be served by way of publication of summon in the newspapers Veer Arjun and the Statesman.

Having heard to the Ld. Counsel for the plaintiff, this court has also perused the record and this court is also of the considered opinion that the defendant cannot be served through ordinary mode of service, therefore, the defendant is ordered to be served on the last known address of the defendant by way of publication of summon in the newspapers **Veer Arjun and The Statesman**, having circulation in the area of Delhi, on taking of steps by the plaintiff within 10 days from today with the direction to the defendant to file written statement, statement of truth and affidavit of admission/denial within 30 form the date of his service of summons.

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The summons to be issued to the defendant are returnable on **18.09.2025**. Dasti summons are also ordered to be issued to the plaintiff or it's counsel.
