Today, the date is fixed for appearance and hearing.

One petition is filed on behalf of the accused persons on interim bail praying for time on the ground stated therein.

One prayer is received from the Investigating Officer of this case praying for time to submit the Final Form in this case. Let it be kept with the record.

At this stage, out of ten accused persons on interim bail, nine accused persons are present by filing hazira and one accused person, namely, Purnima Pradhan is absent by filing a petition supported by copy of medical documents.

A petition is filed for confirmation of bail on behalf of all the accused persons and another petition is filed praying for adjournment by the accused persons.

The petition praying for time is rejected being not-pressed.

The de facto complainant is present by filing hazira. The de facto complainant files four petitions - one under section 15A(11)(e)(f) of the S.C & S.T (POA) Act praying for travelling allowance, daily allowance and maintenance, another petition

under section 15A(8)(c) of the S.C & S.T Act praying for immediate action against Samir Pradhan, Smt. Sefali Pradhan, Biswajit Sadhukha and Jayanta Kundu, another petition under section 15A(10) of the S.C & ST (PoA) Act praying for video recording of all proceeding and also files an objection against the prayer for bail by the accused persons. Let those be kept with the record.

Ld. Advocate representing the de facto complainant is present.

Ld. Special PP is present.

Now, the petition under section 15A(11)(e)(f) of the S.C & S.T (POA) Act praying for travelling allowance, daily allowance and maintenance are taken up for hearing.

Heard. Considered.

Let the above stated petition be sent to the District Magistrate for disposal in accordance with law.

Thus, the petition is disposed of.

Now, the petition under section 15A(10) of the S.C & S.T (PoA) Act praying for video recording of all the proceeding of this case is taken up for hearing.

Heard. Considered.

This Court has no mechanism to conduct all the proceedings of this case under video recording and as such, the instant petition is rejected.

Thus, the petition is disposed of.

Now, the petition under section 15A(8)(c) of the SC & ST (POA) Act, 1989 read with 15A(6) of the SC & ST (POA) Act, 1989 is taken up for hearing.

Ld. Advocate for the de facto informant submitted that on 29/01/2024, the de facto informant was threatened to withdraw the present case and further, he she was threatened with dire consequences by the accused persons, namely, Samir Pradhan, Smt. Sefali Pradhan, Sri Biswajit Sadhukha and Sri Jayanta Kundu, but the local P.S refused to lodge any complaint to that effect and she prays for her protection for her safety.

Heard all sides. Considered.

Considering the above, Inspector-in-Charge of Sankrail P.S is directed to provide necessary protection in accordance with law to the de facto informant of this case, namely Smt. Kajal Pradhan, D/O – Sri Rabin Dhanki & W/O- Sri Swapan Pradhan of Duilya Bakshi Para, P.O – Duilya, P.S – Sankrail, Howrah – 711302.

Let a copy of this order be forwarded to the Inspector-in-Charge of Sankrail Police Station.

Let the interim bail of the accused persons be extended till the next date.

Now, the petition praying for time is considered and allowed.
