

TR Case No. 3 of 2024

Order No. 17 Dated: 24.12.2024

Today the record is put up on the petition filed by the Ld. Advocate on behalf of the two accused persons namely for 1) Biswanath Das and) Sangram Panda @ Shiba who file separate petition praying for their enlargement on bail at any condition. Two separate power (vokatnamas) are filed on behalf of the above named two accused persons by Ld. Advocate Sri Sajis Halder. Let the said powers be kept with the record.

The above bail petition of the accused persons is shown served upon the Prosecution.

Thus, heard the above bail application in the presence of both sides. Ld. Advocate while praying for their bail submitted that investigation of the case is completed and as such their further detention is no longer required. It is further more submitted that co-accused Binod Kumar Shaw @ Raki who is said to be the principle accused of this case has already been enlarged on bail by the Hon'ble Court and as such the Ld. Advocate while praying for their bail prays for parity of the consideration of the bail for the above named two accused persons.

Ld. P.P raised strong objection saying that there is a bar u/s. 37 of the NDPS Act so far the nature of case is there against the accused persons.

Now after having heard both sides, I have carefully perused the nature of the case against the accused persons and after careful consideration of the nature of the case, which being that allegedly commercial quantities of ganja were recovered from their as well as of other accused person's conscious possession.

Considering so their prayer for bail is rejected.
