

NDPS Case No. 03 of 2024

Order No. 04 dated: 02.07.2026.

The case record is placed before this Court today on the strength of a put up petition filed on behalf of the accused person namely Biswanath Das along with a separate petition being accompanied with server copy of an order dated 01.07.2026 passed by the Hon'ble Court in CRM (NDPS) No. 1278 of 2026 along with an affidavit by the Ld. Counsel, Sajis Halder, affirming the genuinity of the said order. It is prayed on behalf of accused namely Biswanath Das to allow the accused person to furnish the bond as directed by the Hon'ble High Court.

Ld. Advocate Sajis Halder on behalf of the said accused person has stated in his letter head that the server copy of the said order of the Hon'ble High Court is a genuine one.

Perused the application.

Heard.

It appears from the solemn order dated 01.07.2026 that the Hon'ble High Court Calcutta has been pleased to allow the bail prayer of the accused/petitioner in the following terms:

“.....Accordingly, the petitioner viz, Biswanath Das shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only), with two sureties of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Judge, Special Court (NDPS Act), Howrah.

If on bail, the petitioner shall also make himself physically available on each and every date so fixed by the learned Special court/trial court and shall not leave the district of Howrah without prior permission of the learned Special Court/trial court....”

Accordingly, the accused person is at liberty to furnish bond.

Ld. CJM Howrah is requested to fit the bonds and to send the same along with the report to this court pursuant to fitting of those bonds.

Let a copy of this order be sent to the Ld. CJM, Howrah for information and taking necessary action.
