This order of mine shall dispose of the bail application filed on behalf of applicant Jasvir Kaur @ Jasso in the above-noted FIR. Learned counsel for applicant has argued that applicant has been falsely implicated in this case and has not committed any offence as alleged in the FIR. As such, applicant may kindly be released on bail.

2. On the other hand, APP for the state appeared and opposed the bail application filed on behalf of applicant on the ground that the offence committed by the accused is grievous in nature and requested for dismissal of the bail application.

After hearing the rival submissions made by learned counsel for applicant as well as learned APP for the State and perusing the court file minutely, I am of the considered view that applicant/ accused in custody since 15.08.2019 and conclusion of trial will take its due time, therefore, to reduce the burden on state, applicant/ accused deserve the leniency of bail. Accordingly, bail application stands allowed. As such, applicant/ accused is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.60,000/- with one surety in like amount. Bail bonds/ surety bonds furnished, which are accepted and attested. Papers be tagged with the main file and put up with the file on the date fixed.
