The application u/S.483 BNSS arising out of Panchla P.S. Case No. 167 of 2026 dated 06.05.2026 u/Ss. 326(g)/324(5)/3(5) of BNS filed by the accused/petitioners namely, 1] Sk. Kibriya @ Sk. Golam Kibriya @ Maya & 2] Md. Fayez Alam, is taken up for hearing.

The accused/petitioners have stated on affidavit that no application has been pending or rejected before or by the Hon'ble High Court till date.

Perused the petition and the C.D. Heard both sides.

Ld. Advocate appearing for the petitioners submitted that the accused/petitioners are in custody from 06.05.2026 and it is alleged that the FIR has been lodged on the basis of surmise and conjecture and it is prayed to enlarge them on bail.

Ld. P.P appearing for the State referred the relevant portion of the C.D and submitted to reject the prayer for bail.

On perusal of the record it appears that this case relates to the alleged offences punishable u/Ss. 326(g)/324(5)/3(5) of BNS, and it is alleged in the FIR that on 06.05.2026 at about 2.30 AM while the de facto complainant was sleeping in his house both the petitioners caused mischief to his factory by setting it on fire and as a result, the entire factory has been damaged and he sustained a loss more than Rs.2 lakhs.

On perusal of the materials lying in the C.D., it appears to me that incriminating materials have been collected against both the petitioners indicating their involvement in the alleged crime and the prayer for bail of the petitioners is rejected accordingly.

C.D and T.C.R be returned, if any.

The Cr. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
