The application u/S.482 BNSS arising out of Uluberia P.S. Case No. 249 of 2026 dated 08.05.2026 u/Ss. 126(2)/117(2)/118(2)/109/351(2)/3(5) of BNS filed by the accused/ petitioners namely, 1] Bapon Maity @ Bapon Chandra Maity, 2] Naren @ Guddu Maity @ Narendra Nath Maity & 3] Partha Maity, is taken up for hearing.

The petitioners have stated on affidavit that no application has been pending or rejected before or by the Hon'ble High Court till date.

Perused the petition and the C.D. Heard both sides.

Ld. Advocate appearing for the petitioners submitted that the co-accused is on bail and an FIR was lodged against the present petitioners and other accused on false and fabricated allegations and it is prayed to allow the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Ld. P.P appearing for the State referred the relevant portion of the C.D and submitted to reject the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Ld. Advocate for the de facto complainant also raises objection and submitted that the victim suffered serious injuries on his head and it is prayed to reject the prayer for anticipatory bail.

On perusal of the record it appears that this case relates to the alleged offence punishable u/Ss. 126(2)/117(2)/118(2)/109/351(2)/3(5) of BNS, and it is alleged in the FIR that on 07.05.2026 in between 9.30 PM and 10 PM one Pritam Dutta son of the de facto complainant was sitting opposite of Annapurna Mess Shop at Chandipur area and at this point of time the present petitioners and other accused came there and started assaulting with bamboo and iron rod out of previous grudge and as a result, he sustained serious injuries on his head and he was removed to hospital and he was admitted in ICU in a private hospital.

On perusal of the materials including the injury report lying in the C.D., I do not find any room to consider the prayer for anticipatory bail of the present petitioners at this stage of investigation.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners namely, 1] Bapon Maity @ Bapon Chandra Maity, 2] Naren @ Guddu Maity @ Narendra Nath Maity & 3] Partha Maity, is considered and rejected.

C.D and T.C.R be returned.

The Cr. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
