ORDER

1. This order disposes off bail application of accused described in detail herein above. Accusation leading to the registration of this FIR is that complainant was praying by reading Shri Gutaka Sahib by sitting in Verandah on a cot in his house. At that time, his son who was in a bad condition came there and started abusing the complainant and pushed the cot, resultantly complainant fell on the

ground and Shri Gutaka Sahib also fell on the ground. Thereafter, accused picked up Shri Gutaka Sahib and put it in the Chulla. Complainant tried to save Shri Gutaka Sahib from the chulla but in vain. Next day accused put the ash in a packet and after sitting on the motorcycle which was being driven by Ranjit Singh @ Kala (applicant) went away from the house.

2. It is alleged on behalf of accused that accused/applicant has not touched any religious book. the name of accused has been falsely involved in this case.

3. Application has been opposed by the State.

4. After hearing the learned counsel for both the sides and going through the matter laid before me, without expressing my opinion on the merits of the case, I am of the opinion that custodial interrogation of the accused in this case is not indispensable for effective investigation nor pre-trial custody will be in the interest of Justice. Resultantly, the application is allowed and it is ordered that in the event of arrest of the applicant-accused, described in detail herein above, accused be admitted to pre-arrest bail by the Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions as provided under section 438 (2) of Cr.P.C. i.e. accused shall join the investigation as and when so desired and

directed by the investigating officer, that accused shall not give any threat or inducement to the prosecution witnesses. The accused shall continue appearing in the Trial Court unless appearance is specifically exempted.

Before parting with this order. Let it be clear that all said and observed herein before is only for the purpose of deciding the application in hand shall not have any effect upon the merits or ultimate out come of the case.

Copy of this order be sent to the Trial Court. Record of present bail application is ordered to be consigned to the record room.
