Order No.13 dt.12.3.25.

Record is put up by petition filed on behalf of appellant.

Appellant files another petition duly supported by affidavit praying for an order allowing permission as to whether occupational charge and rental charge will be deposited simultaneously or not.

Appellant also files another petition praying for an order allowing the appellant to deposit the occupational charge on installment basis. Petition is supported by affidavit.

Copies are served and objection raised.

Heard both sides.

Perused the petitions. Considered.

Order passed by this court vide order no.12 dt.01.3.25 is very much clear as regards to payment of occupational charge and there cannot be any ambiguity in that respect.

As regards to another prayer for installment in depositing occupational charge for the period for which the appellant has not deposited any amount before the trial court is considered and considering submissions of both sides, appellant is permitted to deposit the same in two installments within the time prescribed by this court while passing order no.12 dt. 01.3.25. Both the petitions are accordingly disposed of.
