Fresh suit has been received by way of assignment by random allocation from filing section today. It be checked and registered as per rules.

Present : Ms. Jyoti Yadav, Ld. Proxy Counsel for the Plaintiff.

I have heard the Ld. Counsel and perused the record. I am satisfied about the maintainability of the suit as a commercial suit.

Now subject to Plaintiff's taking steps, issue summons of this suit to the Defendant by all possible modes for 14.09.2026, indicating that Plaintiff has instituted a suit against her relating to a commercial dispute, it is hereby summoned to file her Written Statement that also contains a statement certifying authenticity of document, if any, filed by her. An affidavit of admission/ denial of document filed by the plaintiff(s) shall accompany her Written Statement without which, her Written Statement shall not be taken on record. Where copy of documents are filed by her, the Index to her Written Statement shall also specify as to in whose custody, power and control are the original thereof.

If she seeks inspection of document filed by the plaintiff, she may do so by filing an application, not later than 7 days from receipt of these summons. In such case, receipt of these summons shall only be deemed to be complete only after inspection is provided by the Plaintiff(s). Upon inspection, summons shall be deemed to be duly served and her Written Statement shall be filed within 30 days of the

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service of present summons as aforesaid.

In case, she fails to file her Written Statement within the aforesaid period of 30 days, upon showing cause, the Court may allow him to file the same on such other day, not later than 120 days from the date of service of these summons, as may be specified and on terms ordered by Court. On expiry of the said 120 days, she shall forfeit the right to file her Written Statement and the Court shall not allow the same to be taken on record.

It is also required to appear in this Court in person, or by a pleader duly instructed and able to answer all material questions relating to the suit, or be accompanied by some person able to answer all such questions, on 14.09.2026 at 10.00 AM, to answer the claim. It is further directed to produce on the said day, all documents in her possession or power upon which she shall base his defence or claim for a set-off or counter-claim. Take notice that, in default of her appearance on the day before mentioned, the suit may be heard and determined in her absence.

Plaintiff is also directed to file the screen shot of blue tick in case of service through WhatsApp and delivery report in case of service through E-mail.
