At this stage, accused has appeared and she has been apprised about the today's court proceedings and next date of hearing.

Today before the Court, the accused states that she is ready to settle the present theft matter with BSES. A.R. of the complainant states that he can at his end give a rebate of 35 % only. Since the accused is ready to settle present theft matter, with the intervention of the Court, both the sides have arrived at settlement, which is as follows :

- (1) The accused is ready and willing to pay Rs.60,000/- towards full and final settlement of present theft bill.
- (2) The settlement amount of Rs.60,000/- shall be paid in one

installment on or before 05.10.2023. The installment shall be paid with BSES Office, Hari Nagar. The BSES will accept payment in cash.

(3) It is agreed that the accused having agreed to settle present theft matter with BSES shall not institute any civil, consumer or criminal complaint/case against BSES in respect of the impugned bill.

List before this Court on 10.11.2023. Signature of A.R. of the complainant and the accused be taken on the order sheet.

Since the accused has appeared, no need to issue NBWs against her.

Earlier date fixed i.e. 18.01.2024 stands cancelled
