

Bail Matters 237-2026, 238-26 and 239-26
SHIVANGI SHARMA, MUKESH KUMAR SHARMA AND
PUSHPA SHARMA Vs. STATE
147/2023 (Mukherji Nagar)

1. These are **three separate bail applications u/s 482 BNSS** moved by the applicants/accused persons **Shivangi Sharma, Mukesh Kumar Sharma and Pushpa Sharma seeking anticipatory bail**. However, the same are being heard together as the allegations against the accused persons are common and overlapping.
2. Reply has been filed by the IO. Same is taken on record.
3. Arguments heard. Record perused. Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused submits that investigation is complete and charge-sheet has been filed; accused/applicants were bound down under Section 41A Cr.P.C and were charge-sheeted without arrest.
4. Ld. Subs. Addl. PP for the State has strongly opposed the present application and has prayed for its dismissal.
5. I have heard Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused, Ld. Subs. Addl. PP for the State and have perused the record. It is reflected in the reply of the IO itself that notice under Section 41A Cr.P.C was issued to the accused/applicants; charge-sheet has been filed and

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accused/applicants Mukesh Kumar Sharma and Pushpa Sharma have been charge-sheeted without arrest while accused/applicant Shivangi Sharma has been kept in Column No.12.

6. In the above facts and circumstances and in view of the law laid down in *Arnesh Kumar vs. State of Bihar, AIR 2014 SC 2756* as well as *Satender Kumar Antil vs. CBI, (2022) 10 SCC 51* the present applications are allowed and applicants/accused Shivangi Sharma, Mukesh Kumar Sharma and Pushpa Sharma are admitted to anticipatory bail. It is accordingly ordered that in the event of arrest, they shall be released on bail on furnishing the bail bond in sum of Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand Only) with one surety of like amount to the satisfaction of the IO/SHO concerned, subject to the following terms and conditions:- (i) The applicants/accused shall join the investigation as and when required by the IO/SHO; (ii) During the course of the trial, the applicants/accused shall not extend any kind of threat directly or indirectly or through electronic mode to the complainant or his/her family members or any other public witness; (iii) The applicants/accused shall not get himself/herself involved in any other criminal case; and (iv) The applicants/accused shall remain present in the Court during the course of the trial.

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7. The present applications are disposed of in terms of the above order.

8. A copy of this order be given *dasti* to Ld. Counsel for the accused/applicants and to the IO and be also sent to the Ld. JMFC concerned for information.
