1. Reply not filed by Ld. APP but he opposed the bail application orally.

2. Heard on the bail application moved on behalf of applicant / accused **Sunit Dutt @ Bau Son of Shiv Dayal.** In support of the bail application, it has been submitted that the accused/applicant is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. The trial will take long time. So, no useful purpose will be served by detaining the accused in judicial custody. Thus, prayed for concession of bail to applicant / accused **Sunit Dutt @ Bau Son of Shiv Dayal.**

3. On the other hand, the learned APP for the State submitted that the the applicant/accused is involved in serious offences. So, he should not be granted concession of bail.

4. Heard. Record perused. There there are serious allegations against the accused in the FIR and offence under Section 309 (6) BNS is punishable with imprisonment for life, or with rigorous imprisonment for a term which may extend to ten years. So considering the gravity of the offence the present application of applicant **Sunit Dutt @ Bau Son of Shiv Dayal** is

dismissed. Application stand disposed off. Be tagged with the relevant remand papers.
