This petition is coming for hearing before me on this day in the presence of Thiru.P.Elanchezhiyan, Advocate for the Petitioner/Accused and of Public Prosecutor for the Respondent and this Court made the following

ORDER

This petition is filed U/s.483 of BNSS for seeking bail.

Prosecution case is that the FIR was registered as against the Petitioner/Accused for the alleged offences punishable U/Ss.109, 115(2), 118(1), 126(2), 191(2), 191(3), 296(b) and 351(3) of BNS for the alleged occurrence on 14.05.2026 and the Petitioner/Accused was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 15.05.2026.

The Learned Counsel for the Petitioner/Accused has contended that the Respondent Police have registered an FIR as against the Petitioner/Accused and he is falsely implicated in this case and he has not committed any offence as alleged in FIR. He further stated that the injured was discharged from the hospital. Hence, prays to allow the petition.

The Petitioner/Accused is in judicial custody for the past 18 days.

The Learned Public Prosecutor contended that the Petitioner/Accused is in judicial custody for the past 18 days only. As per FIR, there is specific overtact against him. The offence is grave in nature. The investigation has not yet been completed. Hence, he has serious objection to release the Petitioner/Accused on bail. However, admitted that the injured was discharged from the hospital.

Heard both sides.

Considering the rival submissions of both sides and considering the strong objection of the learned Public Prosecutor and facts and circumstances of the case and considering that the offence is grave in nature and also considering the version of FIR and the investigation has not yet been completed, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the Petitioner/Accused.

Hence, the petition is dismissed.
