This order shall dispose of the application filed by the applicant, Sh. Aman Saini, for the pre-mature release of the FDR amounting to Rs.2,50,000/- in his name.

The present applicant was the petitioner in MACT no. 1051/2023. Vide an award dated 31.07.2025, this Tribunal awarded the applicant a total sum of Rs.5,00,000/- in full and final settlement of his claim. As per the scheme of the award, out of the said total, Rs.2,50,000/- was released immediately, whereas Rs.2,50,000/- was kept in the form of one FDR for the period of one year in his name.

The applicant has moved present application for the pre-mature release of FDR of Rs.2,50,000/- on the ground that he requires money for his further education and research work.

I have heard the applicant and perused the application.

The applicant submits that he has passed his B.A. LL.B. (Hons.) from National Law University, Delhi in the year 2025 and he now requires money for his further studies and research work.

In view of the facts that the FDR is for a period of one year and is about to mature and that the applicant is a law graduate and well aware of his rights, the present application for release of FDR in the name of applicant is allowed. The Manager, State Bank Of India, District Court Complex, Sector-10, Dwarka, New Delhi is directed to release the entire amount along with accrued

interest lying in the form of FDR in the name of applicant (Sh. Aman Saini), as per rules. Accordingly, the said application is disposed of and let the same be tagged with main file.

An attested copy of this order be sent to the Manager, State Bank of India, District Court Complex, Sector-10, Dwarka, New Delhi for compliance.
