Heard. Despite opportunity reply to the bail application has not been filed by the State and the bail application has been orally contested by the learned APP for the State.

Heard the arguments on regular bail. Police record has been produced by HC Malkeet Singh. The accused/applicant of this case has been alleged to be found in possession of 50 ltr., lahan or and as per the police record, the recovery stands effected from the accused. Learned APP for the State has submitted that recovery stands effected as per the police record and also there is one other case pending against the accused.

This is the first application for bail filed by the accused. As per record, no other bail application of aforesaid accused is pending before any Court of law. Statement of HC Malkit Singh has been recorded in this regard. In these circumstances having regard to the gravity of offence alleged against the accused, ongoing situation of Covid-19 and recommendations formulated by the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court, High Powered Committee to de-congest the jails, bail application is considered and allowed, subject to the accused furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs. 30,000/- with one surety in the like amount. Bail bonds and surety bonds have been furnished, which are accepted and attested. Release warrants be issued immediately. Papers be attached with the remand papers, which is fixed for 15.12.2021.
