1. Arguments heard on the bail application of accused Sukhjinder Singh.

2. Briefly the facts of the case of the prosecution are that the accused alongwith his co-accused was apprehended in possession of 25 boxes/Cases of liquor.

3. Accused-applicant has moved application for bail on the ground that he has been falsely implicated. He has further averred that he is in custody since 03.07.2018 and he will abide by all the terms and conditions to be imposed by the court, if he is released on bail.

4. Notice of the bail application was given to the prosecution. The learned APP for the State, opposing the bail application of accused-applicant.

5. I have heard the submission made by the Ld. APP for the State and Ld. Defence Counsel and perused the material on record carefully.

6. Accused has been arrested for the reasons and found in possession of 25 cases of liquor. Recovery has already been effected from the accused. Accused is in custody since 03.07.2018. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the accused in custody, rather it will be burden on the State Exchequer. Moreover, co-accused already granted bail vide order dated 12.07.2018. Therefore, in view of discussion made herein, the accused-applicant is admitted on bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of ₹ 30,000/- with one surety in the like amount. Further bail is being granted subject to following conditions :-

- (i) That he shall not jump over the bail or tamper with the prosecution evidence nor shall try to win over the witnesses.
 - (ii) That he shall join investigation as and when required by the police.
 - (iii) That he shall not leave the country without prior permission of the court.
7. The bail bonds and surety bonds not furnished. Bail application

stands disposed of, accordingly. Papers be tagged with the remand papers.
