Apprehending arrest, the applicant has filed the instant
application under Section 482 CrPC for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR
No.23 dated 27.04.2016 U/S 406, 420 of IPC, PS Behram.

2. Notice of bail application was issued to the State, learned Addl
PP appeared on behalf of the State.

3. As per prosecution version present FIR was registered
against applicant-accused Amarjit Mehmi and his son Tek Chand for
duping Kuldeep Kumar and his brother Ashok Kumar on the pretext of

sending Kuldeep Kumar abroad. During the course of investigation, applicant was declared proclaimed offender vide order dated 28.10.2016. However, order dated 28.10.2016 was quashed by Hon'ble High Court in CRM-M-54154-2025 applicant apprehending his arrest, has filed the present application for grant of anticipatory bail.

4. Learned counsel for the applicant contended that order of declaring applicant as proclaimed offender has been set aside by Hon'ble High Court vide order dated 04.11.2025 passed in CRM-M-54154-2025. Applicant-accused is innocent and has committed no offence. Applicant is also ready to join the investigation. As such, the applicant may be granted pre-arrest bail.

5. ASI Balihar Singh has made a statement that applicant has already joined the investigation and is no more required for investigation.

6. As per statement of ASI Balihar Singh the applicant has already joined the investigation and is no more required for investigation. Being so, the present bail application is hereby allowed and applicant is directed to appear before the Investigating officer as and when called upon for investigation. However, in case applicant fails to appear before the Investigating Officer as and when called, the prosecution shall be at liberty to apply for cancellation of the bail. Bail papers be consigned to record room.
