The application u/S.483 BNSS arising out of Jagacha P.S. Case No. 9 of 2026 dated 14.01.2026 u/Ss. 310(4)/310(5) of BNS filed by the accused/petitioner namely, Alope Parui, is taken up for hearing.

The accused/petitioner has stated on affidavit that no application has been filed or rejected before or by the Hon'ble High Court till date.

Perused the petition and the C.D. Heard both sides.

Ld. Advocate appearing for the petitioner submitted that the accused/petitioner is in custody from 12.06.2026 and no incriminating materials were seized from his possession and it is prayed to enlarge him on bail.

Ld.P.P appearing for the State placed the C.D and opposed the prayer for bail.

On perusal of the record it appears that this case relates to the alleged offences punishable u/Ss. 310(4)/310(5) of BNS and it appears from the FIR that the present petitioner is not named in the FIR and he was arrested subsequently and it appears from the C.D. that his name has been transpired in course of the interrogation of other accused. Charge sheet has been submitted in this case.

On perusal of the materials lying in the C.D., I do not find any incriminating materials against the present petitioner. Accordingly, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

Hence, it is

Ordered -

that the application under section 483 of BNSS filed by the accused/petitioner is considered and allowed.

The accused/petitioner namely, Alope Parui may find bail on furnishing bond of Rs.2,000/- with two regd. sureties of Rs.1,000/- each, subject to the satisfaction of Ld. C.J.M, Howrah.

C.D and T.C.R be returned.

The Cr. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.

Let a copy of the order be sent to the Ld. C.J.M, Howrah for information and taking necessary action.
