The application u/S.482 BNSS arising out of Liluah P.S. Case No. 233 of 2024 dated 01.05.2024 u/Ss. 420/406 of IPC filed by the accused/petitioners namely, 1] Chandan Chowdhury & 2] Jayashree Chowdhury, is taken up for hearing.

The petitioners have stated on affidavit that no application has been pending or rejected before or by the Hon'ble High Court till date.

Perused the petition and the C.D. Heard both sides.

Ld. Advocate appearing for the petitioners submitted that the present petitioners have refunded a sum of Rs.3,02,000/- which is the subject matter of this complaint and it is prayed to allow the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Ld. P.P appearing for the State referred the relevant portion of the C.D and submitted to reject the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Ld. Advocate appearing for the de facto complainant submitted that the de facto complainant has received the said sum of money and he has no objection if the present petitioners are granted anticipatory bail.

On perusal of the record it appears that this case relates to the alleged offence punishable u/Ss. 420/406 of IPC.

Having regard to the submissions made by both sides, I do not find any impediment in allowing the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners.

Hence, it is

Ordered -

that the application under section 482 of BNSS filed by the accused/petitioners is considered and allowed.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest accused/petitioners namely, 1] Chandan Chowdhury & 2] Jayashree Chowdhury, shall be released forthwith on furnishing bond of Rs.1,000/- each with one regd. Surety of like amount, subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and on condition as laid down under Section 482(2) BNSS.

C.D and T.C.R be returned.

The Cr. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
