The application u/S.483 BNSS arising out of Howrah P.S. Case No. 94 of 2026 dated 27.02.2026 u/Ss. 319(2)/318(4)/338/336(3)/336(4)/3(5) of BNS filed by the accused/petitioner namely, Arup Kumar Ghosh, is taken up for hearing.

The accused/petitioner has stated on affidavit that no application has been pending or rejected before or by the Hon'ble High Court till date.

Perused the petition and the C.D. Heard both sides.

Ld. Advocate appearing for the petitioner submitted that the accused/petitioner is in custody from 20.05.2026 and the lone FIR named accused has been enlarged on bail after being surrendered before the Ld. CJM, Howrah and other accused person also is also now on bail and no specific allegations have been leveled against the present petitioner and it is prayed to enlarge him on bail.

Ld.P.P appearing for the State placed the relevant portion of the C.D and submitted to reject the prayer for bail.

On perusal of the record it appears that this case relates to the alleged offences punishable u/Ss. 319(2)/318(4)/338/336(3)/336(4)/3(5) of BNS, and it appears from the FIR that the de facto complainant Kalyan Roy son of late Kalachand Roy lodged a complaint with the Officer-in-charge of Howrah PS alleging that some unknown persons using his credentials and personal information had managed to procure a loan from LIC Housing Finance Ltd., though he did not approach for any loan to any authority nor he executed any document and on enquiry with the respective branch of LIC Housing Finance Ltd., it came to his knowledge that said loan was sanctioned through an agent namely Sandip Roy.

On perusal of the materials lying in the C.D., it appears to me that the investigation is in progress and incriminating materials against the present petitioner are accumulated in course of investigation and I do not find any room to consider his prayer for bail at this stage.

Accordingly, the prayer of bail of the petitioner stands rejected.

C.D and T.C.R be returned, if any.

The Cr. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
