The application u/S.483 BNSS arising out of Shibpur P.S. Case No. 175 of 2026 dated 30.04.2026 u/Ss. 316(2)/318(4)/303(2)/336(3)/338/3(5) of BNS filed by the accused/petitioner namely, Raghunath Sinha, is taken up for hearing.

The accused/petitioner has stated on affidavit that no application has been pending or rejected before or by the Hon'ble High Court till date.

Perused the petition and the C.D. Heard both sides.

Ld. Advocate appearing for the petitioner submitted that the accused/petitioner is in custody from 22.05.2026 and he is a goldsmith and had no accesses to the vault and he is in no way connected with the alleged crime and it is prayed to enlarge him on bail.

Ld. P.P appearing for the State referred the relevant portion of the C.D and submitted that sufficient incriminating materials are collected against him in course of the investigation and it is prayed to reject the prayer for bail.

Ld. Advocate appearing for the de facto complainant submitted that the present petitioner is the active member of racket which misappropriated gold from the vault by making false entries in the melting register and the investigation is in progress and several other persons are involved in the alleged crime and it is prayed to reject the prayer for bail.

On perusal of the record it appears that this case relates to the alleged offence punishable u/Ss. 316(2)/318(4)/303(2)/336(3)/338/ 3(5) of BNS, and it appears from the FIR that one Gautam Das authorized legal counsel/ General Manager of Ulike Stock & Securities Pvt. Ltd., with jewelery showroom under the brand name Tanishq lodged the same against one Soumyajit Das who is an employee of Tanishq showroom, Howrah on the allegations of illegally removing gold ornaments from the vault of the company received under gold exchange scheme by practicing fraud along with various other allegations.

On perusal of the materials lying in the C.D., it appears that several persons have been examined and interrogated and several raids have been made for seizure of several documents and other incriminating articles and from the statement of the persons recorded by the I.O till date and from the documents so far seized in connection with this case clearly establishes incrimination of the present petitioner with the alleged crime, I do not find any room to consider his prayer for bail at this stage of investigation.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail of the present petitioner stands rejected.

C.D and T.C.R be returned, if any.

The Cr. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
