This petition is filed on behalf of the Petitioner to modify the condition imposed in bail U/S.483(1)(a) of BNSS.

This petition is coming on this day for final hearing before this Court in the presence of Tmt.J.Sabitha, Advocate for the Petitioner/Accused and Thiru.P.Pakkiri, Public Prosecutor for the State and after perusing the petition and after hearing the arguments of both sides, this court delivers the following:

ORDER

Heard on both side.

This condition relaxation application is perused. Both sides arguments are heard in open court.

The Learned Counsel for the Petitioner/Accused has contended that the Petitioner/Accused has been released on bail for the alleged offences u/sec. 123, 275 of BNS Act r/w 24(1) COTPA 2003 as per order of the Hon'ble Principal District & Sessions Court, Cuddalore in CrI.M.P.No.1354/2026, dated

09.04.2026 with a condition that he should appear and sign before the Respondent Police Station daily at 10.30 A.M., for 30 days and thereafter on every 1st day of English Calendar month till charge sheet filed. The Petitioner/Accused was languishing in Central Prison from 09.04.2026 after obtaining bail order for more than 27 days for the reason, not furnishing the sureties. If he released on bail, he will furnish bail bonds or sureties. The petitioner is in judicial custody for the past 86 days in Central Prison at Cuddalore. Hence, Hence, she prays to modify the condition imposed by this Court.

The Learned Public Prosecutor contended that the native of the Petitioner/Accused is Ramanathapuram District. If the condition is modified, he will abscond. Hence, he has raised serious objection to modify the condition.

Considering the both side rival submissions and considering the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the nature of the offence and other aspects, this Court is not inclined to modify the earlier condition.

Accordingly, this petition is dismissed.
