

State vs Amit Bansal

ORDER

1. This order of mine shall dispose of a bail application moved by the applicant/accused namely Amit Bansal on the ground that the allegations levelled in the FIR are vague. It has been stated that mere mentioning of plot number or alleging that information is received regarding certain people, who are involved in impersonation and selling the land, is not sufficient to lodge FIR, in the absence of any document or a person who is victim of the act committed by the accused. It has been stated that he has been falsely implicated in the present case and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. He is in custody since his arrest.

2. In reply, the Ld. APP for the State stated that the present case was registered on the basis of secret information to the effect that the accused in connivance with his co-accused have sold the land wrongly by forging document. The Ld. APP for the state prayed that the bail application of accused persons be dismissed.

3. I have heard the Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused and Ld. APP for the State and have gone through the police file. In the present case, there are serious allegations against the accused person. Hence, I do not find any justification for granting concession of bail to the accused person and his bail application is hereby dismissed. However, this order shall not effect the merits of the present case.
