Heard on the bail application filed by accused/applicants Pinderjeet Singh @ Raja, wherein it was pleaded that accused are innocent and have been falsely implicated in the present case. He is in judicial lock up since 30.05.2022. As such, learned counsel for accused/applicant has prayed for release of accused/applicant on bail.

Upon notice, learned APP for the State, appeared and opposed the bail application on the ground that accused has committed serious offence. As such prayer for dismissal of the present bail application has been made.

I have considered the contradictory versions of the contesting parties and have deliberated over the arguments advanced in the light of documents, peculiar facts and circumstances and submissions made.

Perusal of the file reveals that the present FIR was registered on the statement of complainant Beant Singh son of Ranjit Singh on the allegations that in the intervening night of 24/25.01.2022 some unidentified persons has committed theft of 10 solar plates, one controller along with approximately 30 feet wire from his fields and later on he came to know that his solar system were stolen by Mandeep Singh @ Vicky, Gurbhej Singh, Pinderjit Singh, Harjit Singh, Daljit Singh @ Kaka, Gurpreet Singh @ Ghona and Sukhbir Singh and Labh Singh @ Labha. He also came to know that the aforesaid persons also committed theft in the fields of his familiar namely Manjit Singh son of Pritam Singh resident of village Kera Khera. Lastly he prayed for taking legal action against the aforesaid persons. On the basis of said statement, present FIR

was registered.

Police record perused. Perusal of the file further reveals that FIR has been registered for the commission of offence punishable u/s 379 IPC and the applicant/accused Pinderjit Singh the prime accused in the present case. Accused is alleged to have committed offence, which are serious in nature and the investigation is at its initial stage. The alleged theft of solar plates is heavy recovery which has caused a serious financial loss to many innocent people. In these circumstance, I do not deem it fit to grant the concession of bail to accused. As such, present bail application stands dismissed and disposed of. Papers be attached with remand papers.
