ORDER
(Delivered on 02.09.2025)

1. The present application has been filed by the applicant/accused seeking regular bail under Section 483 of BNSS, in the subject captioned FIR.
2. Notice of the bail application was given to the prosecution. Shri Aseem Goyal, learned Public Prosecutor for the State has appeared to contest the bail application. Record has been requisitioned.
3. Shri A.S. Parmar, learned Chief Legal Aid Defence Counsel has submitted that the latter has been falsely implicated in the present case

and that he has nothing to do with the alleged offence. The applicant/accused is in custody since 31.07.2025 and it will take long time to conclude the investigation and trial. No purpose will be served by keeping the accused/applicant behind bar for indefinite period. With these submissions, he has submitted that accused/applicant may be granted the concession of regular bail.

4. Per-contra, Shri Aseem Goyal, learned Public Prosecutor for the State has argued that applicant/accused is involved in a serious offence, so he is not entitled for the concession of bail. It has been prayed that the bail application be dismissed.

5. I have heard rival contentions of both the sides and perused the record.

6. The present FIR has been lodged on 19.04.2025, on the basis of secret information regarding involvement of applicant/accused Gurmeet Singh son of Gora Singh along with co-accused Gurdit Singh alias Gora son of Gurmail Singh and Lovepreet Singh alias Labhi, in narcotic trade as well as committing thefts/decoities. Secret informer further informed that all the accused persons armed with deadly weapon are making preparation for committing dacoity while sitting near drain in the area of Behbal Khurd. If raid is conducted, they can be apprehended red handed. On the basis of said information, case was registered and raid was conducted at the disclosed place, from where applicant/accused Gurmeet Singh along with co-accused Gurdit Singh alias Gora and Lovepreet Singh alias Labhi were apprehended and arrested. During interrogation, iron toka, pipe etc..

were recovered from their possession. During investigation, accused Lakhwinder Singh alias Mappa, Dalbir Singh alias Dallu, Sabar Ali, Pardeep Singh alias Dimpy and Himanshu were nominated vide DDR no.8 dated 02.08.2025. As per record, applicant/accused along with other co-accused was arrested on the basis of secret information. Recovery has already been effected from the possession of applicant/accused. The accused/applicant is in custody since his arrest on 31.07.2025. Conclusion of investigation and trial is likely to take a long time, so, no useful purpose will be served by keeping the accused/applicant in custody for an indefinite period, rather it would be burden on the State Exchequer. Hence, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, accused/applicant is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Illaqa/Duty Magistrate subject to the conditions that he shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or to the police, he shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence in any manner, he shall not leave country without prior permission of the court and he shall appear on each and every date of hearing before the trial court.

7. The bail application stands allowed accordingly. A copy of this order be sent to the quarter concerned. File be consigned.
