

Mukesh Kumar Vs. State, BA-174-2026

Present: Shri NS Nayyar Advocate for the applicant/accused.
Shri PP Singh Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Heard. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State on the instructions from the Investigating Officer submits that the accused-applicant has joined investigation and he is not required by the police for custodial interrogation.

Under these circumstances, the interim order dated 31.01.2026 is made absolute, but the accused-applicant shall remain bound by the following conditions:-

1. that the applicant shall not leave the country without prior permission of the Illaqa Magistrate till the presentation of challan and thereafter without permission of the learned trial court;
2. that the applicant shall not directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer;
3. that the applicant shall continue to cooperate with the investigating agency;
4. that the applicant shall regularly attend the hearings before the learned trial court;
5. that the applicant shall not indulge in the commission of the such offence of similar nature in future.

In case the accused-applicant misuses the concession of bail by absenting from the proceedings, the learned trial court shall be at liberty to cancel this bail order. File be consigned to the record room.
