Today, the date is fixed for appearance and hearing.

The sole accused person on C.B, namely, Ajoy Sharma is present by filing hazira.

The de facto complainant is present by filing hazira along with her Ld. Advocate. The de facto complainant files two petitions – one petition under section 15A(11)(e)(f) of the S.C & S.T (POA) Act praying for travelling allowance, daily allowance and maintenance and another petition another petition praying for passing necessary direction upon the District Magistrate, Howrah to provide immediate relief under Rule 12(4)(6) of the S.C & S.T (POA) Rules on the ground stated therein. Let those be kept with the record.

Ld. Advocate for the de facto complainant is present.

Ld. Special PP is present.

Ld. Advocate for the accused person is present.

Now, the petition one under Section 15A(11)(e)(f) of the SC & ST (POA) Act, 1989 praying for daily allowance, travelling allowance and maintenance expenses is taken up for hearing.

Ld. Advocate for the de facto complainant has also relied upon the solemn judgment dated 10/11/2023, passed by the Hon'ble High Court at Bombay, Nagpur Bench in Criminal Writ Petition being No.759 of 2022.

Let the above noted petition be sent to the District Collector for necessary disposal in accordance with the Law.

Thus, the petition under Section 15A(11)(e)(f) of the SC & ST (POA) Act, 1989 is disposed of.

Now, the petition praying for passing necessary direction upon the District Magistrate, Howrah to provide immediate relief to the de facto complainant under Rule 12(4)(6) of the S.C & S.T (POA) Rules is taken up for hearing.

Ld. Advocate for the de facto complainant submitted that in this case F.I.R was lodged on 23/07/2023 and the investigation has culminated into charge-sheet on 14/12/2023, but till date, the de facto complainant has not received any relief amount. Accordingly, he prays for passing necessary direction.

Heard. Considered.

Let the above noted petition, filed under Rule 12(4)(6) of the S.C & S.T (POA) Rules be sent to the District Collector with a request for necessary disposal in accordance with the Law and it is further requested to send an intimation before this Court after disposal of the prayer of the de facto complainant, namely, Neha Prasad as per Rule 12(4)(6) of the S.C & S.T (POA) Rules.

Thus, the petition under Rule 12(4)(6) of the S.C & S.T (POA) Rules is disposed of.
