30-08-2025	1. The instant anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioners namely, 1. Suraj Thakur @ Surya Deo Thakur aged about 48 years S/O- Mahavir Thakur, 2. Chandra Thakur aged about 56 years S/O- Mahavir Thakur, 3. Baijnath Thakur @ Vaidyanath Thakur aged about 83 years S/O-Baldeo Thakur, 4. Chandra Kala Devi aged about 34 years W/O- Suraj Thakur, and 5. Sangita Devi aged about 40 years W/O- Chandra Thakur all R/O- Village- Koilakh Ward No. 7, PS-Rajnagar, District-Madhubani, u/s. 482 of the BNSS, who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Rajnagar PS case No. 137/2025, instituted u/s- 189(2), 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 76, 118(1), 303(2), 329(3), 308(3), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of the BNS. 2. The prosecution case in brief is that the informant Soni Devi has alleged that on 02.04.2025 at 07:00 AM, she was doing her household work and upon hearing noises she came out and saw that accused persons including petitioners, armed with clubs and iron rod, were abusing. When she protested, petitioners/accused Suraj Thakur and Chandra Thakur assaulted her. Co-accused Prashant Thakur assaulted on her hand with iron rod due to which her hand got fractured. Co-accused Kanhaiya Thakur and Rakesh Thakur outraged her modesty. On raising alarm, when her husband and father-in-law came to save her. Accused persons including petitioners assaulted them due to which her father-in-law sustained injury. Accused persons including petitioners entered into her house and took gold and silver ornaments and also took cash of Rs. 25,000/- from her house. 3. The learned counsel for the petitioners appearing before the Court and submitted that no other regular or anticipatory bail application filed on behalf of petitioners either before sessions court or before Hon'ble High Court, Patna. Petitioners are not carrying antecedent except this case. Petitioners are not juvenile and no any case pending in any Court. Petitioners are quite innocent and all have committed no offence as alleged rather all have falsely been	

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continued 30-08-2025	implicated into this case. No country banned articles seized from conscious possession of petitioners. Petitioners are the man of means and man of means are ready to stand by as sureties for petitioners to satisfaction of the Court. Petitioners have been dragged in the present case out of personal enmity. No such occurrence has taken place so far. The offence as alleged are bailable except section 303(2) of the BNS which is not specific against petitioners. The moment petitioners came to know about this case, they have rushed before this Court and pray for bail. Therefore, it has been prayed to grant anticipatory bail to petitioners. 4. Per contra. Ld. APP for the state has opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of petitioners. 5. Heard Ld. Counsel of both parties and perused the case record as well as case diary. After considering the facts and circumstances of the case as there is allegation of assault against petitioners and the nature of injury of informant is grievous as mentioned in the injury report coupled with the fact that investigation is still pending. Therefore, keeping in view the submission of the Ld. Counsel for the parties and facts and circumstances discussed herein above, the prayer of anticipatory bail on behalf of aforesaid petitioners is hereby rejected.
