This petition is filed on behalf of the Petitioner to release him on Anticipatory Bail U/S.482 of BNSS.

This petition is coming on this day for final hearing before this Court in the presence of Thiru.P.Elanchezhiyan, Advocate for the Petitioners/Accused and Thiru.P.Pakkiri, Public Prosecutor for the State and after perusing the petition and after hearing the arguments of both sides, this court delivers the following:

ORDER

Heard on both side.

This Anticipatory bail application is perused. Both side arguments are heard in open court.

The Learned Counsel for the Petitioners/Accused has contended that the Petitioners/Accused are apprehending arrest in the hands of Respondent/Complainant for the alleged offences punishable U/S.296(b), 115(2), 118(1) and 351(2) of BNS, they may be put into humiliation. The date of alleged occurrence is on 15.05.2026. The date of FIR is 15.05.2026. The FIR is pending before the Learned District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate, Kurinjipadi. They are innocent of the said offence and they were falsely implicated in this case. They are respectable law abiding citizen and having permanent place of residence. They will not abscond and undertake to appear when and where the court orders to do so. They are having sufficient solvent sureties. The injured person was discharged from the hospital. Hence, prays to allow the petition.

The Learned Public Prosecutor represented that the injured person was discharged from the hospital.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the representation that the injured person was discharged from the hospital, this Court is inclined to grant Anticipatory bail to the Petitioners/Accused with the following stringent conditions:-

In the result, this application is allowed and the Petitioners/Accused are ordered to be enlarged on bail in the event of arrest or on their surrender on or before 12.06.2026 before the Learned District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate, Kurinjipadi;

(a) the petitioners shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the said court and produce his residential proof;

(b) As per Rule 14(7) of the Criminal Rules of Practice of 2019, the Accused shall affix their photograph in the surrender application filed before the Concerned Court and also submit his identification proof as stipulated for the surety and also furnish atleast two of their identification marks in the surrender application.

(c) the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and produce copy of their Aadhar card or bank pass book to ensure their identity;

(d) the petitioners shall report before the Respondent Police daily at 10.30 A.M. for 15 days from the date of release and thereafter appear and sign before the S.H.O., on every Sunday at 10.30 A.M., until the Final Report is filed;

(e) the Petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

(f) the Petitioners shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(g) the Petitioners shall not attempt to contact any of the prosecution witnesses directly or through any other person or in any other way try to tamper with the evidence or influence any witnesses or other persons related to the investigation;

(h) the Petitioners shall not in any way contact the defacto complainant's family. If any complaint is received from the defacto complainant, the Respondent Police is entitled to apply for cancellation of Anticipatory Bail.

(i) In case of the condition No. (a) to (h) are violated, it is open to the investigating officer to file appropriate application for cancellation of Anticipatory Bail granted hereby, as held by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K. Shaji/vs/State of Kerala (2005) AIR SCW 5560).
