Present: Sh. Harsh Dikshit, Ld. Proxy Counsel for complainant.
Accused is absent.
Process server HC Ajay Singh in person.

At this stage, separate statement of the Process Server HC Ajay Singh regarding execution of Process u/s 82 Cr.PC issued against accused has been recorded.

Perusal of report regarding execution of process u/s 82 Cr.P.C shows that process was published on the conspicuous part of the house of aforesaid accused. Process was also affixed on the notice board of the court and process was also read publically near the house of accused.

It is clear that 30 days has been elapsed since publication of aforesaid process but despite publication aforesaid accused did not appear before the court or before police official.

Therefore, in view of statement of Process Server HC Ajay Singh and after perusal of the record, it appears that accused Satish , S/o Sh. Matu Ram is absconding and evading. Therefore, accused Satish, S/o Sh. Matu Ram is hereby declared absconder.

Let copy of this order be sent SHO concerned for registration of case FIR for offence u/s 174A IPC/209 BNS against the accused within 3 days from the receipt of the order.

As the accused is already an absconder in the present case, therefore, nothing further remains to be done in the present proceedings. The present proceedings are accordingly, disposed off with the direction that same be revived as and when the accused is arrested or his whereabouts are traced out.

Matter stands disposed of.

Case file be consigned to Record Room after due compliance.
