I don't know at present, which is the insurance company? There is no impediment to produce documents in that regard. It is true to suggest that the group insurance premium is paid by the company, therefore deduction is not reflected in the pay slip. My company has paid group life insurance Rs.24,99,723/- (Twenty four lakhs ninety nine thousand seven hundred twenty three rupees only).
