

The Amritsar Transport Co. Vs Improvement Trust and others

Present: Shri MS Thakur, Advocate for plaintiff.

Suit received by entrustment. Report of Reader Seen. It be checked and registered. Alongwith the suit, plaintiff has moved an application U/o 39 rules 1 and 2 CPC for grant of ad-interim injunction.

Heard. The plaintiff has filed the present suit for permanent injunction restraining the defendants, their agents, assignees and representatives permanently from in any manner interfering in the peaceful possession of the plaintiff or forcibly dispossessing the plaintiff or from demolishing any part of the suit property as mentioned in the head note of the plaint. To prima-facie support its case, plaintiff has placed on record authority letter, photocopy of certificate registration, photocopy of photographs, photocopy of order, electricity bill, jamabandi for the year 2014-15, site plan, photocopy of mutation, photocopy of bills, photocopy of adhaar card. At this stage, balance of convenience lies in favour of plaintiff/applicant. But the suit property needs to be preserved during the pendency of this suit. As such, defendant is directed to maintain **status-quo** qua present position i.e. five shops marked as ABCDEFGH and two rooms, verandha, kitchen and stair case and terrace at first floor marked KLMNOPQRIJ bearing khewat no. 636/610 khatauni no. 772 khasra no. 2R/30/2 measuring 15 marlas to the extent of 6/75 marlas, situated at Dalhousie Road, Pathankot, falling withing the revenue estate of village Bhadroya HB no. 333, Tehsil and District Pathankot till further order, except by due course of law.

Compliance of order 39 Rule 2 and 3 be made within 24 hours. Let notice of the suit and stay application be issued to defendants for on filing of PF and copy of plaint and stay application for 30.10.2023.
